"SCORE CARDS" DURING COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

How to Complete your Score Cards

- 1) Due to COVID-19 Restrictions cards are **not** exchanged at start of play.
- 2) a) Your card as "Player A" must be completed by a <u>marker</u>, (Player D) who will sign the card at the end of round and submit it to Competition Organiser or Handicap Secretary as appropriate.
 - b) You will **complete** their card and sign it as the marker & return to Competition Organiser or Handicap Secretary as required. (if requested to do so).
 - c) On completion of each hole you should agree & record the number of strokes taken.
- 3) The names of both players must be <u>printed</u> in appropriate spaces on both cards along with reason for Card e.g. General Play, Date, Tee's used and Handicaps (if known).

ALL TYPES of CARD: - It is important to record a score against every hole. (See Note below)

HANDICAP CARDS: Just enter number shots taken on all holes. (Maximum of Par +5).

<u>GENERAL PLAY CARDS:</u> If a player picks up before holing-out a **Net Double Bogey** should be entered (if in doubt enter a score of Par +5).

<u>S'FORD COMPETITION:</u> If a player picks up before holing-out or can't score a **Net Double Bogey** should be entered (if in doubt enter a score of Par +5).

The entering of points is preferred but not necessary.

MEDAL COMPETITION: Enter total number of shots taken on each hole.

Some competitions may limit maximum strokes per hole (Usually Par +5) but please check with competition organiser before playing.

NOTE: - All high scores will be reduced to "Net Double Bogey" by England Golf for Handicapping.
